

Guidelines for Student Computer Lab Usage

1. Use of university computing and network systems/equipment is for academic and administrative purposes only.
2. You may not attach any computer, equipment, peripheral or otherwise access the network without prior permission.
3. The computer lab is for the use of current AMU students, staff and faculty. Access is limited to those possessing a current university ID.
4. You may not run or install on any university computer system a program which could result in the eventual damage to a file or computer system. This is directed towards, but not limited to, the classes of programs known as computer viruses, Trojan horses and worms.
5. You may not perform acts that are wasteful of computing resources or which unfairly monopolize resources to the exclusion of others.
6. University equipment must be treated with care. Thus, there is no eating, drinking or smoking allowed in the SCL.
7. Electronic equipment is offered for use "as is". Software and hardware may or may not be the most current versions. Users are responsible for determining program compatibility.
8. Use resources efficiently. Accept limitations or restrictions on computing resources.
9. Obey copyright law. AMU expects users to know, understand and apply copyright law.
