Definitions

- (1) “Number of Students Who Began Program” is the number of students who began the program who are scheduled to complete the program within the reporting calendar year.
- (2) “Students available for graduation” is the number of students who began program minus the number of “Students unavailable for graduation,” which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active military duty.
- (3) “Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.
- (4) “Completion Rate” is the number of Graduates divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation.
- (5) “Graduates available for employment” means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment. “Graduates unavailable for employment” means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- (6) “Graduates employed in the field” means graduates who report that they are gainfully employed within six months of graduation in a position for which the skills obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position.
- (7) “Placement Rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- (8) Exam Date is the date for the first available exam after the students completed the program.
- (9) “# Taking Exam” is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of published program length and for whom the reported exam is the first exam that was available after their completion of the program.
- (10) “Number Who Passed First Exam Taken” is the number of students who took and passed the licensing exam in the reported calendar year on the first attempt.
- (11) “Passage Rate” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who pass the exam the first time that they take it by the number of graduates who took the licensing exam for the first time after completion of the program.
- (12) Salary is as reported by the student. Not all graduates reported salary.
